## Performance notes

Tremolos (3 beam or equivalent) are always unmeasured and as fast as tempo allows.

**T-Tr** in wind parts denote 'timbral trills'. These are microtonal trills, and fingering choices are left to the performer. They are always possible on the pitches specified, and the trill interval should ideally be narrower than a quarter tone.

The term G.P. (General Pause) denotes that all performers are silent in a given bar, and does not affect tempo.

Standard notation for accidentals is used. Occasional cautionary accidentals do not imply a change to this rule.

Duration is c.15 minutes

Although the 5 poems are set separately, the music should run without a break.
